Travel

Thanks to its location at the heart of Germany and the European continent, Hannover is easy to reach from all points of the compass. Whether by road, rail or air, the Hannover location is easy to reach and offers optimum transport connections.

- The Exhibition Grounds enjoy direct access to the East/West and North/South arteries of the German autobahn network.
- High-speed trains (ICE, IC and EC) travelling in all directions operate to and from Hannover at hourly and half-hourly intervals. Scheduled and special train services are also provided to the railway station "Hannover Messe/ Laatzen".
- Direct flights to Hannover Airport are available from numerous major European cities. Via Frankfurt, Munich, Amsterdam, Brussels, Paris and London air travellers can reach Hannover from all parts of the world.
- The Exhibition Grounds is boast two underground rail links with the city centre.

Transfer to the Exhibition Grounds

The airport is approx. 11 km north of Hanover and approx. 20 km away from the Exhibition Grounds.

All year round from Hannover Airport to Main Railway Station by local railway connection (S-Bahn), Line S5. The S- Railway Station is situated between terminal B and C.

From Main Railway Station to the Exhibition Grounds, entrances NORD 1 + 2 by tram, line 8. A ticket is necessary.
